#### Transition Team Update

We are moving into the next stage of the transition process — a phase in which we envision and explore possibilities for our future. This critical period in the life of our community will require creativity and out-of-the box thinking — and that will take energy.

As a small church, we have much to do and few hands to do it. Many needs, wants, ideas and distractions tug at our attention and we must be faithful in the use of our time and resources. To ensure we have the energy to discern our future path, we must prioritize the work of the church.

Together, we need to decide: what things are most important; how we will share the workload to get those things done; and what things we will let go.
